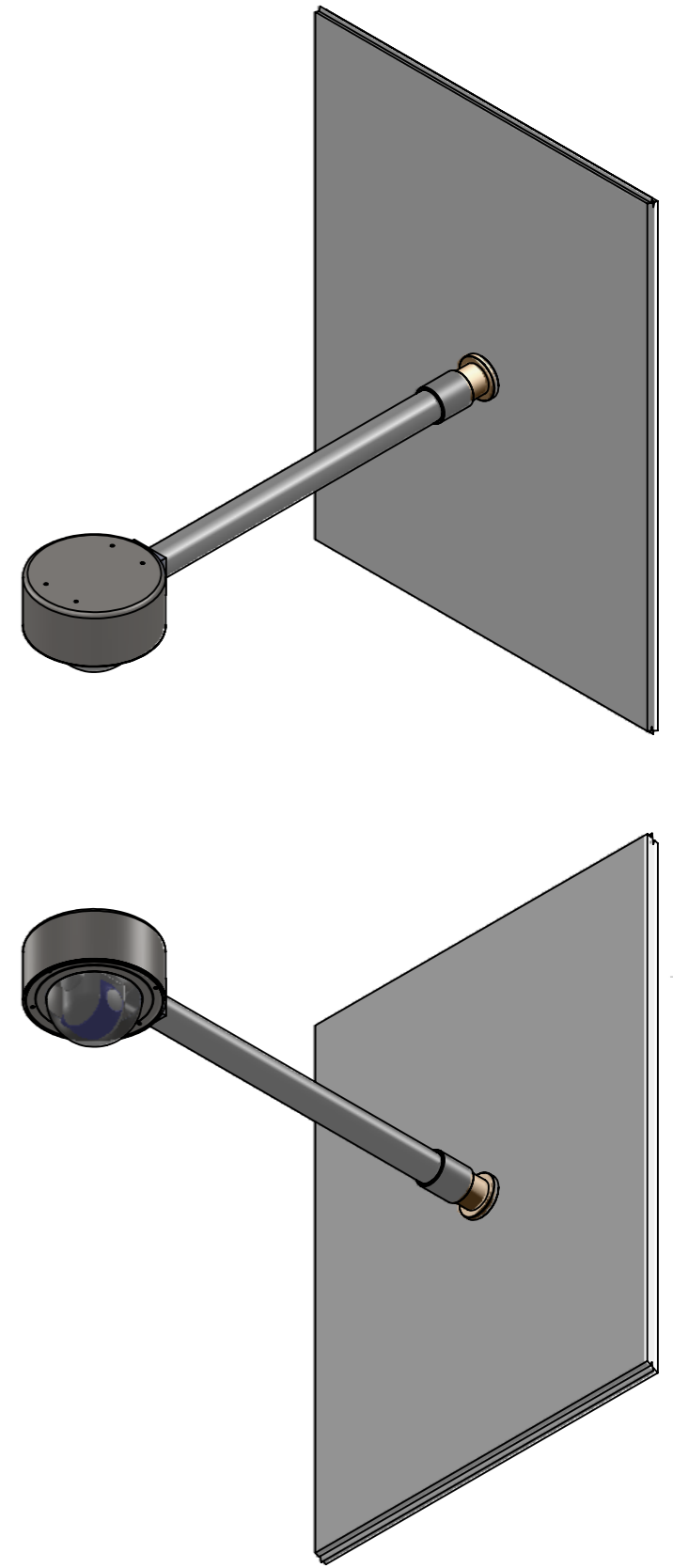
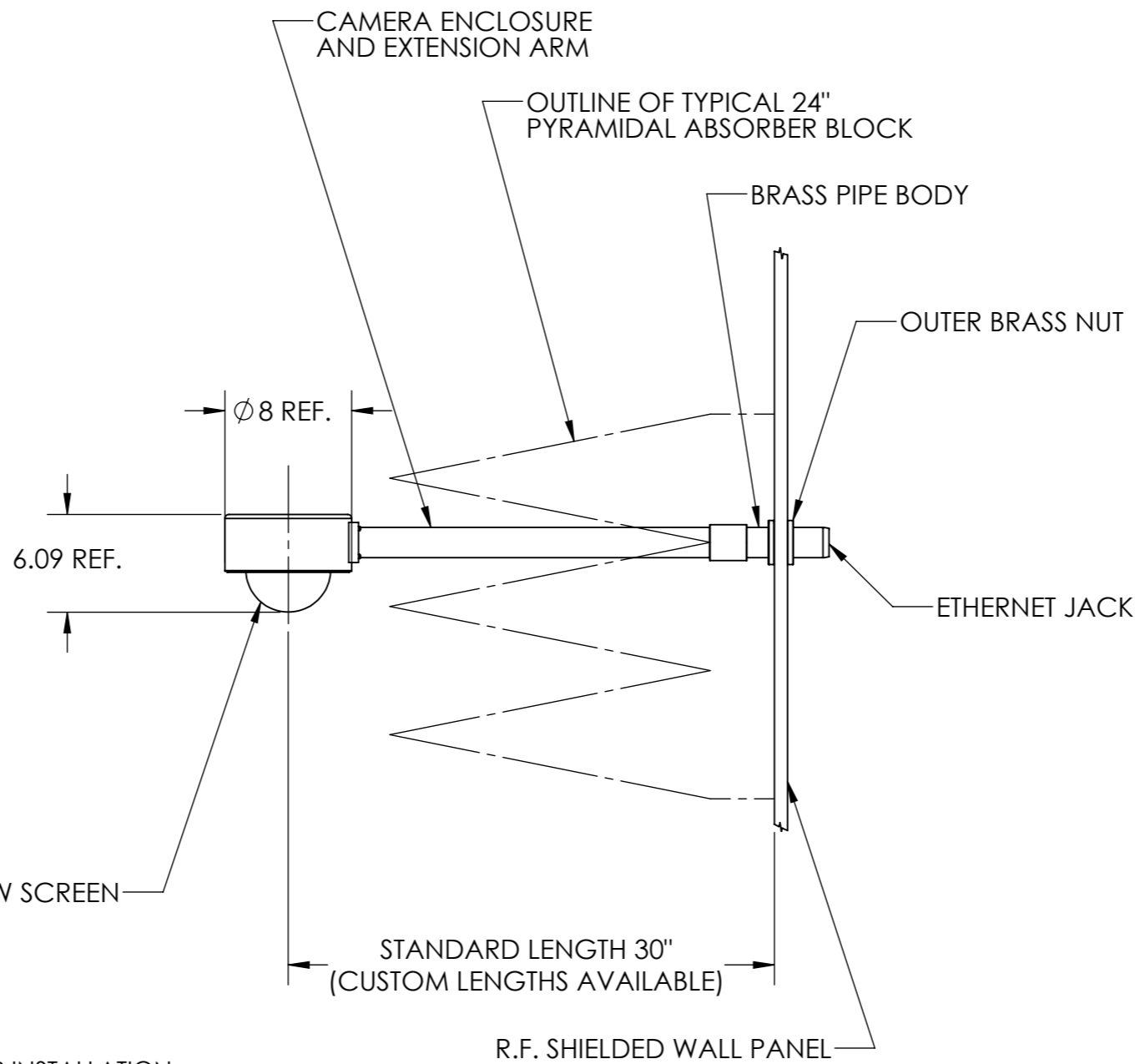


CAMERA VIEW SCREEN



INSTALLATION:

- DETERMINE PREFERRED LOCATION ON CHAMBER WALL FOR INSTALLATION.
- REMOVE ANY ABSORBER OR FINISHES THAT LIMIT ACCESS TO THAT AREA OF THE WALL.
- DRILL A  $\phi$  2" HOLE THROUGH THE WALL. DEBURR BOTH SIDES OF THE HOLE.
- LIGHTLY SCUFF BOTH SIDES OF THE SHIELD PANEL AROUND THE HOLE WITH A MEDIUM SCOTCH-BRITE PAD, THEN WIPE CLEAN WITH A RAG AND METHYL HYDRATE.
- REMOVE THE OUTERMOST BRASS NUT FROM THE ASSEMBLY, THEN INSERT THE THREADED BRASS PIPE BODY THROUGH THE HOLE. RE-INSTALL THE BRASS NUT ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE ENCLOSURE.
- LEVEL THE CAMERA HOUSING AND THEN COMPLETELY TIGHTEN THE BRASS NUTS.
- INSTALL THE ETHERNET CABLE BETWEEN THE JACK IN THE END OF THE BRASS PIPE BODY AND THE OUTPUT OF THE P.O.E. POWER INJECTOR (NOT SHOWN).
- CONNECT P.O.E. POWER INJECTOR TO ITS POWER ADAPTOR AND TO THE CONTROL COMPUTER, FOLLOWING THE INSTALLATION STEPS PER THE CAMERA SOFTWARE GUIDE.
- RE-INSTALL ABSORBER, OR FINISHES, AS REQUIRED.
